#### **About us**

Youth Association for a Greater Europe was founded by students from the leading European universities such as Sciences Po Paris and MGIMO (Moscow) in 2012 to promote exchange and contribute to mutual understanding between youth representatives in Greater Europe. We support their cooperation through projects in the field of culture, science, sports, education and entrepreneurship.

The main project of the Association is the international summer youth forum «Greater Europe Meetings» which has attracted 251 participants from more than 35 countries since 2013. Such organizations as the Council of Europe, the European Court of Human Rights, UNECSO, Ecole des Mines, Académie Diplomatique Internationale in Paris and other leading European institutions contributed to the success of our events.

#### Idea and goal in 2018

Despite the deteriorated state of relations in Greater Europe, we stay committed to our goal and keep gathering bright minds of the European continent in the framework of our annual Forum. The heart of the 2018 Forum will be the EU-EUAU Diplomatic School which aims at provoking students to rethink the state of affairs in Greater Europe and to elaborate means of resolving the current crises.

The Diplomatic School consists of 3 modules: Lectures – Workshops – Negotiations. Each module includes intensive knowledge-sharing and development of communication and negotiation skills.

The main goal is to work on the possibility of the EU-EAEU cooperation through joint preparation and signing of written «Memoranda of Understanding (MoU)» by representatives of different countries.
